## **Exemption**

### **Section 248 of the *Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Act 2006***

I, Neil Jensen, AUSTRAC CEO, pursuant to paragraph 248(1)(a) of the *Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Act 2006* (AML/CTF Act), hereby exempt the Commonwealth of Australia, represented by the Department of Human Services ABN 90 794 605 008 of 65 Canberra Avenue, Griffith ACT 2603 and the Commonwealth Services Delivery Agency ABN 29 468 422 437 of 57 Athallon Drive, Greenway ACT 2900 from the following specified provisions of the AML/CTF Act:

- (a) Items 23 and 24 in Table 1, subsection 6(2).

### **Conditions**

Pursuant to paragraph 248(2)(b) of the AML/CTF Act, the exemption is subject to the following conditions:

1. The person granted the exemption must inform the AUSTRAC CEO or delegate of any changes that may affect the exemption and/or conditions imposed by this written instrument within 14 days from when the change affecting the exemption occurs.
2. This exemption only applies in the following circumstances:
  - a. in the provision and use of the Income Management System's BasicsCard.
